READ : Minutes of 82nd meeting of the Board of Directors of KPTCL held on 23.06.2012 – Subject No.82/09 in respect of sparing of land for construction of EHT line terminal bays with associated equipments in KPTCL Substation/Receiving Stations for terminating power supply lines and evacuation lines of Independent Power Producers(IPP) and other connectivity issues.

PREAMBLE : In the 82nd meeting of the Board of Directors of KPTCL held on 23.06.2012, the proposal regarding sparing of land for construction of EHT line terminal bays with associated equipments in KPTCL Sub-stations / Receiving Stations for terminating power supply lines and evacuation lines of IPP's and other connectivity issues were discussed. It was noted that based on the requisitioned load / contract demand power supply is provided at the appropriate levels and whenever a consumer desires power supply directly from the HT or EHT Lines consumers have to construct the lines either under self-execution or DCW basis. Also IPPs including NCE power projects interconnect to KPTCL Stations through transmission lines and HT/EHT consumers evacuate excess power from their generating plants. Presently all the above categories of consumers / IPPs have to create their own infrastructure to interconnect to the KPTCL grid to obtain connectivity. In many cases the consumers suffer because of the non-availability of space. The proposal placed for consideration of the Board addressed the above issues by putting in place a system depending on feasibility and judicious assessment to facilitate construction of the required infrastructure on KPTCL premises at the cost of the applicant.

The proposal provides for creation of infrastructure at the cost of applicant on KPTCL premises on payment of one time non refundable fee from IPPs/NCE project developers as per a formula. Further to guard against misuse of KPTCL land, the proposal also provides for the formation of a Committee which would decide on the need for creation of the infrastructure keeping in view all the relevant factors such as Perspective Plan, Provisions of the Supply Regulations etc. The proposal was debated and Board decided to accord approval to the proposal.

Hence this Order.

Approval is hereby accorded to constitute a Committee of the following officers to examine the feasibility of developing necessary infrastructure either for supply of power or for evacuation vis-à-vis requests received from Generators or HT/EHT consumers subject to the parameters stated hereunder.

1. Chief Engineer, Electy. (P&C),KPTCL : Chairman
2. Chief Engineer, Electy. (RT & R & D),KPTCL : Member

3. Concerned Zonal Chief Engineer, Electy. : Member
4. Superintending Engineer, Elecl. (Planning) : Member & Convener.

Parameters to be considered.

1. The request of the applicant concerned shall be considered as one time facilitation subject to all other conditions being fulfilled.
2. The request of the applicant shall be considered subject to his accepting to meet the entire estimated cost towards developing the required infrastructure.
3. It shall be made clear to the applicant that the infrastructure being built on our premises is at his cost and subject to his payment of one time non-refundable fee without any claim whatsoever on the portion of the premises used for developing infrastructure.
4. The Committee shall analyse in detail the technical feasibility and inevitability of developing the said infrastructure on our premises duly considering the Perspective Plan of KPTCL and the possible need for such portion of the land in the years to come.
5. Unless the Committee is categorically satisfied in terms of the Perspective Plan as well as future load growth in mind, it shall not permit the Zonal Chief Engineer to extend such facilitation.
6. The Committee shall in its proceedings bring out in detail the circumstances and the rationale considered for permitting such facilitation.

Subject to the above Committee approving the said facilitation for building necessary infrastructure on KPTCL's premises at the cost of the applicant, the concerned applicant, as the case may be, shall be liable to pay additionally the required fee as detailed below:

A. For termination of Evacuation Lines constructed by the IPP's & Generating stations to the KPTCL Sub stations/Receiving Station:

- a) An one-time non-refundable charges to be calculated as below depending upon the geographical area of connectivity:

One time non-refundable amount to be paid in Rs = Z X guidance value per sq.ft X area occupied by the equipments in sq. ft X 30 years X 7% (Z=1.75 for Group A cities, 1.5 for Group B cities and 1.25 for others)

AND

- b) O&M expenses at 1.5% of Capital cost of the infrastructure with 12% escalation every year shall be collected from all existing IPP's and future IPP's from the financial Year 2012-13

O&M expenses/annum in Rs = Capital cost of the equipments X 1.5%

B. For termination of HT/EHT Lines constructed by HT/EHT applicants to the KPTCL Sub stations/Receiving Station for arranging Power supply:

If the infrastructure to be created for arranging power supply to HT/EHT consumers at their cost is a DEDICATED ONE (i.e for the exclusive use of the consumer), O&M expenses at 1.5% of Capital cost of the infrastructure with 12% escalation every year from the financial Year 2012-13.

O&M expenses/annum in Rs = Capital cost of the equipments X 1.5%

If no space is available in the KPTCL's premises in both the above cases (A) & (B), then the applicant has to purchase land or space at his cost adjacent to the KPTCL premises for putting up the required infrastructure and shall hand over the same to KPTCL free of cost.

C. HT/EHT consumer becoming a consumer cum IPP at a later date:

Shall comply with the financial obligations as at (A) above.

In the event of the Committee deciding to the effect that the request of the applicant cannot be considered, Managing Director, KPTCL will direct the concerned that the applicant shall arrange for the required land or space at his cost adjacent to the KPTCL premises to be handed over to KPTCL free of cost for putting up the required infrastructure.
