Where as the draft of the following rules, further to amend the Karnataka Right to Information Rules 2005 was published in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(1) and (2) of section 27 of the Right to Information Act 2005(Central Act 22 of 2005) in notification no: DPAR 86 RTI 2009 Dated:1.10.2009 Karnataka Gazette extraordinary and inviting objections and suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby with in 30 days from the date of its publication in the official Gazette and where as the said gazette was made available to the public on 1.10.2009. And where as the objections and suggestions not received from the publics.

Now therefore in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) and (2) of section 27 of Right to Information Act 2005 (central Act 22 of 2005) the Government of Karnataka hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Karnataka Right to Information Rules 2005 namely.

Rules

Title and commencement:- (1) These rules may be called the Karnataka Right to Information (Amendment) Rules, 2009.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in Official Gazette.

- Amendment of Rule 4:** In the Karnataka Right to Information Rules, 2005, in rule 4,-
- a. In sub-rule(4) after the words "or in cash" the words "or through Money Order" shall be inserted; and
 - b. After sub-rule(4) the following shall be inserted at the end, namely:-

"The fee so collected through Govt. Money Order shall be credited to Treasury after due acknowledgment as per Karnataka Financial Code or shall be credited to the Treasury after entry in the Cash Book as per KFC."
