**SUBJECT:** Relaxation of number of works to be handled by single turnkey agencies.

**READ :** 1. Order No. KPTCL/B19/1672/90-91 Dt.17.01.2013  
2. Resolution of the 85<sup>th</sup> Meeting of Board of Directors of KPTCL held on 21.01.2013. - Subject No.85/19.

**PREAMBLE:** KPTCL vide Order cited under reference(1) had restricted the number of ongoing works being handled by individual bidder /consortium partner both in KPTCL and ESCOMs to become eligible for participation in KPTCL tenders. This has resulted in lack of adequate response to the tenders being invited by KPTCL in recent times. Board in its 85<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 21.01.2013 debated the matter. It was noted that the purpose of revising the tender document was to attract higher participation and at the same time provide a level playing field to all the agencies. In many of the cases the agencies could not complete their works owing to ROW issues, litigations etc due to which number of ongoing works on hand of the agencies may increase and makes them non eligible for participation in KPTCL tenders. While a ceiling on the number of works on hand was appreciable, non-completion of the same owing to reasons not attributable to the agency had also to be considered while deciding on the fresh conditions. It would be very difficult to demarcate those works where the agency could not be held responsible for the works becoming dormant. After detailed deliberations on the subject matter it was decided to delete the Clause No.11.6.2.7 of Section-I : 'Invitation for Bid', Volume-I: 'Commercial Requirements' in the standard 'Bid Document' which is presently restricting the agencies to participate in KPTCL tenders owing to the number of ongoing works being executed.

Hence this Order.

Approval is hereby accorded to delete Clause No.11.6.2.7 of Section-I : 'Invitation for Bid', Volume-I: 'Commercial Requirements' in the standard 'Bid Document' for inviting bids for construction of 220/110/66KV Sub-stations / Lines including UG Cables and 400KV Lines on Partial / Total Turnkey basis.

Other terms and conditions of the standard 'Bid Document' shall remain unaltered. This shall come into force with immediate effect.
