Sub:- Restoration of delegation of powers regarding condonation of delay in respect of works and purchases.

PREAMBLE:-

KPTCL vide its order cited under reference(2) had withdrawn Delegation of Powers provided to the Zonal Chief Engineers vis-à-vis condonation of delay in respect of execution of works with instructions to forward all such delay condonation proposals with complete justification to the Corporate office for necessary disposal by the Central Purchase Committee. Further, certain amendment in this regard was issued vide order cited under reference(3) above to include withdrawal of the powers in respect of purchases also. Order dated 08.03.2010 cited at reference(3) was mainly to clarify that powers of condonation of delay was withdrawn for all level of officers in respect of the turnkey contracts as well as purchases as Order at reference(2) was silent on this issue. Subsequently, delay condonation proposals are now being forwarded to the Central Purchase Committee for necessary disposal. This has resulted in number of delay condonation proposals being placed in the Central Purchase Committee for clearance causing additional burden on the Central Purchase Committee and delay in disposal of such proposals. Further, it is observed that many of these proposals are minor in nature which can be disposed at the Transmission Zones itself. Hence, it is felt necessary to withdraw these orders referred here above and restore the delegation of powers provided to all CEE's, SEE's and EEE's vis-à-vis condonation of delay in execution of Works and in respect of Purchases as per the Manual of Delegation of Powers which was prevailing earlier.

Hence this Order.

ORDER No.KPTCL/B19/1672/90-91 Bangalore

The orders cited under reference(2) & (3) regarding delegation of powers in respect of delay condonation proposals pertaining to execution of Works and Purchases are withdrawn with immediate effect. The Delegation of Powers provided to all CEE's, SEE's and EEE's vis-à-vis condonation of delay in execution of Works and in respect of Purchases is now restored to that prevailing prior to issue of the above orders and shall be in accordance with Manual of Delegation of Powers,1997. However, delay condonation proposals shall be approved only after audit clearance in respective offices and with complete justification for the same. Further all delay condonation proposals beyond the powers of Chief Engineers as stipulated in the Manual of Delegation of Powers,1997 shall be placed before the CPC for disposal. This shall be for future cases which are not yet referred to CPC.
