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## **Preamble:-**

1. The Government of Karnataka in its order dated 26/11/2004 has issued instructions for adoption of Price Adjustment clause for all works contracts whose estimated cost is Rs.100.00 Lakhs and more and period of completion is 12 months or more as per the Annexure-I to the said order.
2. The Government of Karnataka in its order dated 06/08/2005 has issued Standard Tender Documents for procurement of works specified in Annexure I to VI to the said order, depending on the value of contract.
3. The Government of Karnataka in its order dated 21/03/2007 has mandated the use of Standard Tender Documents for procurement of works by every "Procurement Entity" under the Government (as defined in section 2(d) of KTPP Act).

4. Implementation of Government order dated 21/03/2007 was deferred till 30/06/2008 vide Government orders cited under reference 4 and 5 above.
5. In the Procurement Reforms Standing Committee meeting held on 02/08/2008, the proposal of Public Works Department for certain modifications to the Standard Tender Documents were discussed in detail and certain clauses of the Standard Tender Documents as prescribed in Government order dated 06/08/2005 were modified in Government order dated 14/10/2008.
6. Government in its order dated 21/11/2008 has issued modifications to the Government order dated 26/11/2004 regarding the price adjustment methods.
7. In order to adopt the Standard Tender Documents issued by Government for KPTCL works, a committee headed by Superintending Engineer (Ele), T&P, Superintending Engineer (Civil), Superintending Engineer (P&C), Controller of Accounts (T&P) and others was formed. The committee after examining the various clauses of Standard Tender Documents opined that the Standard Tender Documents issued by the Government could be adopted for all civil works of KPTCL taken up independently. Further the committee commented on certain clauses of the Standard Tender Documents which are in variance with the present practice of KPTCL. However most of the clauses commented by the committee were not applicable for civil works taken up independently.
8. The opinion of the Financial Advisor (A&R) was also obtained regarding the form in which the Earnest Money Deposits and Security Deposits are to be collected. The FA (A&R) has suggested to collect EMD and Security Deposits only in the form of Bankers cheque/Demand Draft/Pay order.
9. Taking note of all these, the proposal of adoption of Standard Tender Documents issued by the Government in KPTCL for all civil works taken up independently was approved. Hence this order.

1. Approval is here by accorded to adopt the **Standard Tender Documents issued by Government of Karnataka** vide G.O dated 06/08/2005 with subsequent amendments issued as

mentioned under reference, **for all civil works** taken up independently **on tender basis**.

2. The following Standard documents issued by the Government shall be adopted for inviting tenders for all civil works taken up independently depending on the value of the work.

Form number	Description of the document	Value of contract
K/W 1	Procurement of Works by inviting open tenders (Item Rate) – restricted to Registered Contractors.	Less than Rs.20 lakhs
K/W -2	Procurement of Works by inviting open tenders (Item Rate) – post – qualification criteria incorporated.	More than Rs.20 lakhs but less than Rs.50 lakhs
K/W -3	Procurement of Works by inviting open tenders (Item Rate) – Two cover tender system.	More than Rs.50 lakhs but less than Rs.100 lakhs.
K/W -4	Procurement of Works by inviting open tenders (Item Rate) – Two cover tender system.	More than Rs.100 lakhs.
K/W -5	Pre –qualification by open invitation of Application – Joint Venture not permitted.	More than Rs.10 crores
K/W -6	Pre –qualification by open invitation of Application – Joint Venture permitted.	More than Rs.10 crores

3. The instructions to the tenderers, formats for submission of tender (unless specified other wise) and the general conditions of contract indicated in the Standard Tender Documents shall not be changed. However, amendments, supplementary instructions if any to the above to take care of local need/specific requirement may be provided in the Data Sheet, Special Conditions of Contract, provided for in the documents.
4. This order will apply for invitation of tenders for all civil works taken up independently, **to be invited here after** and shall not be applicable for tenders already invited and that are under process.
5. The Standard Tender Documents duly incorporating up to date amendments (Form no.K/W-1, K/W-2, K/W-3, K/W-4, K/W-5, K/W-6) is available on KPTCL web site 'e-prasarana' and may be downloaded.

6. The foot notes provided in the Standard Tender Documents are only for the guidance of the Tender Inviting Authority to prepare the documents properly. All foot notes should be deleted in the final text.
7. The form PWG-65 and 66 of tender documents which were being adopted for all civil works, are to be discontinued hence forth.
8. The provisions made in the Standard Tender Documents which are being adopted now for all civil works, supersedes all the corresponding rules, provisions in Accounts Manuals, Audit Manuals and orders etc., to the extent they are not consistent with the corresponding provisions.
9. Amendments to relevant provisions in Accounts Manuals will be incorporated in due course.
