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## **Preamble:-**

1. In the Corporate order dated 23/10/2012, approval was accorded to adopt the Standard Tender Documents issued by Government of Karnataka with all amendments upto 21/11/2008, for all civil works taken up independently on tender basis.
2. The Government in its circular dated 10/01/2014, has directed to refer all disputes in contract agreements to Bangalore Arbitration Centre as per Arbitration Centre Karnataka (domestic and international) Rules 2012 for resolving disputes which will be very economical. Further, in the Corporate note dated 11/06/2014 directions were issued to implement the said Government circular in all future agreements to be executed where Arbitration Clause is to be incorporated.
3. As per the Standard Tender Documents, Arbitration Clause exists only in contracts of value more than 100.00 lakhs (K/W-4). As such, the arbitration clause No. 24 in Document K/W-4 is to be modified as per Government circular dated 10/06/2014.

4. Further, in the Government order dated 19/07/2014, clause No. 3.1 in K/W-1 and 3.2 (b) in K/W-2, K/W-3 and K/W- 4 have been modified to the extent mentioned in the said order.

5. The above modifications/ amendments have to be incorporated in the Standard Tender Documents being used in KPTCL. Hence, this order.
